Large **Ancestral Chart** – Six Generations with space for full information on Birth Date, Birth Place, Marriage Date, Marriage Place, Death Date, Death Place, Cemetery Name, Cemetery Place. The chart folds to 8 1/2 x 11 so that it can be used as a worksheet and updated when written in pencil. Let's you see the Big Picture of your family and where research is needed. Also can be purchased rolled and is suitable for framing.

Shortcut to Genealogy Checklist is a one page list of sources to document, find additional information, and organize what you know about your ancestors. Checklists are available for different time periods. Our companion **Shortcut to Genealogy Sources** book will be available on March 10, 2014. Book describes over 100 sources, what info they contain, & where to find it.

The **Census History Form** has space for 10 census years, and names of father, mother, and up to 10 children. Basic data for the whole family covers a lifetime for most people, and it fits on a single sheet of paper. This is a great tool for analysis, taking with you when you are at the library or in archives. Easily see where everyone resided, their age, and place of birth.

The new **Beginner Tech Guide** is written to help anyone brand new to using a computer. Simply a basic "how to" that is concise. The book has Time to Practice pages for computer, laptop, tablet, smartphone, sending and receiving email and printing out a document.

Civil War Service & Pension Records and **War of 1812 Service & Pension Records** are 4 page handouts. They are full of useful information about Military Record Types, where to find the records and get copies of them. When records are online, website addresses are noted.
